1. INTRODUCTION

- **1.1.** This manual contains information applicable only to the Reliance® Models 500 Series stools.

2. INSTALLATION

2.1. Unpacking

2.1.1. Open the shipping carton carefully and record any shipping damage to the carton or to the contents. 2.1.2. Remove all contents from the shipping carton and note that "knocked-down" shipments have their back supports removed and packed in the carton with the base assembly.





2.2. Assembly

2.2.1. To assemble the adjustable tilting backrest, such as Model 546, refer to Figure 1.




- 2.2.1.1. Place the support bar, Item 3, into the back plate, Item 4, and secure it with the thumb screw, Item 5.
- 2.2.1.2. In order to position the backrest properly, refer to Figure 5. The threaded stud is to be placed thru the slot in the support bar with the chrome acorn nut (Item 10) visible from the top.
- 2.2.1.3. Screw the handwheel, Item 2, Figure 1, onto the threaded stud in order to secure the position of the backrest.
- 2.2.2. To assemble the curved body support on model 556, refer to Figure 2.



"NOTE"- After support bar has been inserted into back support per the assembly instructions (section 2.2), insert stop screw into threaded hole in end of support bar. The #10-24 x ½ Round Head Machine Screw (Part Number 2037299) is shipped in the parts bag.

- 2.2.2.1. Untape the support tubes, Item 3, and swing them up to a vertical position approximately parallel.
- 2.2.2.2. Remove the two position screws, Item 2, from the backrest rods, and insert the rods into the support tubes simultaneously.
- 2.2.2.3. Push the rods down into the support tubes until the arm is at a desired height.
- 2.2.2.4. Adjust the rods slightly until a pair of threaded holes in the support rods appears thru the holes in the support tubes. Replace the two position screws and tighten securely.
- 2.2.3. Refer to the Operating Instructions for adjustments.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1. Seat Height Adjustment

3.1.1. A pedal operated hydraulic lift is used to raise and lower the seat in the Reliance® Series 500 Stool. To raise the seat, push downward on the pedal lever. Note that a stop can be felt at the bottom of the pumping stroke. By exerting enough force to move the pedal beyond this stop, a lowering valve is opened, permitting the stool seat to descend.



"CAUTION"- When raising the seat, ensure that the stool remains clear of any furniture or equipment. Otherwise, the resulting raising force may damage the furniture, equipment or stool.

3.1.2. Lifting the pedal locks rotational movement of the seat with respect to the base, should such a condition be desired.

3.2. Body Support Adjustment (556 Series Only)

- 3.2.1. The curved body support of the 556 Model stool is adjustable horizontally to serve as an arm, abdomen, or back rest and can be swiveled independently of the seat. For horizontal adjustment, loosen the locking handle and position as desired.
- 3.2.2. The body support can be adjusted vertically to any one of five positions indicated by threaded holes in the body support rods. To make the adjustment, remove the two position screws, position the body support at the desired height and insert the screws in the nearest pair of threaded holes. Tighten the screws securely.

3.3. Back Rest Adjustment (546 & 548 Stools)

- 3.3.1. The back rest of the 546 & 548 series stools is adjustable vertically and horizontally.
- 3.3.2. To adjust the rest vertically, loosen the black hand wheel behind the back rest, move it to a comfortable position, then tighten the hand wheel.
 3.3.3. For horizontal adjustment, loosen the thumb
- screw clamp holding the back support bar under the stool seat and move the support bar in or out as desired. Tighten the thumb screw securely after making the adjustment.


3.4. Lubrication

3.4.1. Caster wheels and swivels do not require lubrication.

3.4.2. Lubricate the curved body support mechanism of the Model 556 only if it operates stiffly or squeaks. Introduce a few drops of light oil into the slots of the back support casting holding the support tubes under the stool seat. (This casting is shown as Item 5 of Figure 7.) Work the mechanism back and forth several times to distribute the oil and wipe off any excess.

3.5. Foot Rest Ring Spacers

- 3.5.1. Foot rest ring spacers are recommended for 'M' and 'H' Models in order to raise the ring with the minimum seat height.
- 3.5.2. One spacer for each clip is recommended for 'M' models, and two spacers per clip are recommended for 'H' models. (Refer to Figure 3.)
- 3.5.3. To install spacers, first remove the foot rest ring from the base and disassemble the clips by removing the screws.
- 3.5.4. Screw the stud end of each spacer into the foot rest ring. If two spacers are to be used, screw the second spacer into the first as illustrated.
- 3.5.5. Replace the clips and screws previously removed to the bottom of each spacer.
- 3.5.6. Replace the foot rest ring by snapping the clips in place as illustrated on the stool base legs.



4. Replacement of Parts

- 4.1. When ordering replacement parts, please specify the model number of the stool and the proper part number from the following figures.
- 4.2. When ordering upholstered items, please specify color (or conductive).



"WARNING"- The foot rest ring is intended for lightweight foot support only and is not intended for use as a step/weight bearing support. If repositioning of the body is needed while seated, you must insure both feet are firmly placed on the floor before shifting your weight.



CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Upholstery

When cleaning upholstery, it is suggested that you use all recommended commercial cleaning agents in an inconspicuous spot to check for potential damage to the upholstery material before applying to the entire area to be cleaned.

Day to Day soil:

Remove ordinary dirt and smudges with a mild soap and warm water solution. Dry with a soft, lint-free cloth or towel. For more difficult stains, use of a stronger detergent is recommended; however, follow the detergent manufacturer's instructions closely.

Disinfecting Material:

In order to disinfect, use a 1:9 solution of bleach and water (1 part bleach to 9 parts water). Wipe surface with damp cloth then rinse with water immediately, using a damp cloth.

Special cleaning problems:

The following methods are recommended to clean stains on PreFixx-protected vinyl upholstery. Most stains will be removed when these cleaning agents are used in the following order.

Type 1 Cleaners: Nonabrasive household cleaners to be used with water and a soft cloth.

- Formula 409®~ All-Purpose Spray Cleaner
- Fantastik® Sprav Cleaner
- Other similar household cleaners and bleaches

Type 2 Cleaners: Solvent-type cleaner to be liberally applied with a soft cloth. Dry area with another cloth, rinse with clean water and dry.

- Rubbing alcohol (isopropyl alcohol)
- Lighter fluid (naptha)

Type 3 Cleaners: Strong, active solvent cleaners such as nail polish remover (acetone/water) to be applied with a soft cloth. Stain should be removed with less than six (6) rubs; if stain persists after six rubs, contact manufacturer. Dry area with another cloth, rinse with clean water and dry.



"CAUTION"- These solvents are highly flammable. Exercise proper care in cleaning and notify personnel in area of danger. Wear rubber gloves during all cleaning activity. Use caution in cleaning around buttons, stitching and wooden or other decorative trim, since these solvents could seriously damage such areas.

Cleaning Painted Surfaces

The painted metal surfaces are covered in durable, powdercoated paint which is resistant to scratching and scuffing. It may be cleaned with a clean cloth dampened with mild, soapy water or equivalent household product that uses spray application.

Recommended Infection Control Products

The disinfectant/cleaner products that we have tested and recommend for our upholstery, painted items and plastic covers are as follows.

- Cavicide® Hospital Disinfectant
- Precise® Hospital Foam Cleaner Disinfectant



"CAUTION" - Follow manufacturer's directions for concentration and application of disinfecting material. Avoid prolonged application of any disinfectant/cleaner products, because they may cause staining of upholstery material.
